Starting from 2021-22, we have had four classes in each of Junior Classes 1 to 6.

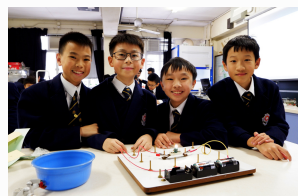


Learning & Teaching
